FAIR CONTRACTS NOW

It's been more than two years since Atlantic City casino dealers and slot techs voted to join the UAW/AC Casino Workers Union. Since then, the union has worked for fair contracts. But casino owners refuse to negotiate fairly.

Casino owner Harrah's Entertainment, Inc. is stalling talks at Caesars and violating federal law by refusing to bargain at Bally's.

A major labor dispute in a major industry in our state hurts all of us: workers, taxpayers and local businesses. There's a growing consensus that it's time to find a fair solution, and State Senator Jim Whelan has made a proposal which could quickly resolve the outstanding issues.

The UAW/AC Casino Workers Union has accepted and is willing to submit all outstanding issues in the dispute to a neutral third party – an arbitrator – to decide. **Atlantic City workers and our unions agree: arbitration is the right way to move forward and resolve this dispute.**
